Simple Present signal words: **always, every, never, normally, now and then, occasionally, often, rarely, seldom, sometimes, usually.**

Put the signal word and the verb into the gaps.

Example: Jake and Ben usually **get** up (to get up) at 6 o'clock. Signal word: **usually**
