simple past + :	I worked at school.
simple past - (negative) :	I didn't work at school. / I did not work ...
simple past ? (question):	Did I work at school?
will future + :	Will I work at school?
will future - (negative) :	I won't work at school. / I will not work ...
will future ? (question) :	Will I work at school?
going to future + :	I'm going to work at school. / I am going ...
going to future ? (question):	Am I going to work at school?
present progressive + :	I am working at school.
present progressive - (negative):	I'm not working at school. / I am not working ...
present progressive ? (question):	Am I working at school?
past progressive + :	I was working at school.
past progressive - (negative):	I wasn't working at school.
past progressive ? (question):	Was I working at school?
