I had not seen the film.	I hadn't seen the film.
You had not seen the film.	You hadn't seen the film.
He/She had not seen the film.	He/She hadn't seen the film.
We had not seen the film.	We hadn't seen the film.
You had not seen the film.	You hadn't seen the film.
They had not seen the film.	They hadn't seen the film.

1. Past Perfect negatives: Make sentences – long form or short form.

1. I had arrived at the station.

I **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)I **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)

2. You had arrived at the station.

You **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)You **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)

3. He/She had arrived at the station.

He/She **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)He/She **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)

4. We had arrived at the station.

We **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)We **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)

5. You had arrived at the station.

You **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)You **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)

6. They had arrived at the station.

They **had not arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative long form)They **hadn't arrived** at the station. (Past Perfect negative short form)
