Present Perfect negative – regular verbs – worksheet

ANSWER

have/has, not + Past Participle

Example (short form): He **hasn't closed** the door.

Write negative sentences (short form) - Present Perfect.

Peter (not to paint) the door.

Peter hasn't painted the door.

Jake and Adam (not to ask) the teacher.

Jake and Adam haven't asked the teacher.

The pupils (not to walk) to school.

The pupils haven't walked to school.

The football team (not to train) today.

The football team hasn't trained today.

The girl (not to carry) the bag.

The girl hasn't carried the bag.

The tutor group (not to decide) to go to Borkum.

The tutor group hasn't decided to go to Borkum.

The students (not to answer) all the questions.

The students haven't answered all the questions.

I (not to clean) my bike.

I haven't cleaned my bike.

We (not to tidy) up our rooms.

We haven't tidied up our rooms.

Bill (not to call) me.

Bill hasn't called me.

The children (not to swim) in the sea.

The children haven't swum in the sea.

You (not to take) the children to the zoo.

You haven't taken the children to the zoo.
