Examples Present Perfect – affirmative, question, negative:

Affirmative: Subject + Have / Has + Past Participle.

Negative: Subject + Haven't / Hasn't + Past Participle.

Question: Have / Has + Subject + Past Participle.

1. Fill in the Present Perfect form and the signal word.

In the garden

The Browns **have started** (to start) working in the garden.

Mr Brown **has** already **cut** (to cut) the grass...

Present Perfect signal word: **already**

...but they **haven't tidied/have not tidied** (not to tidy) the flowerbeds.

They **haven't/have not had** (not to have) the time.

Have they **bought** (to buy) any plants?

Yes. Mrs Brown **has bought** (to buy) a lot of vegetable plants...

...but they **haven't/have not planted** (not to plant) them yet.

Present Perfect signal word: **yet**

Why **haven't** they **done** (not to do) that yet?

Present Perfect signal word: **yet**

Mr Brown **hasn't/has not finished** (not to finish) digging the vegetable garden yet.

Present Perfect signal word: **yet**

Look! He **has** just **sat** (to sit) down. He is tired. Poor Mr Brown!

Present Perfect signal word: **just**
