Simple Past – regular verbs - worksheetThese verbs are called **regular** because they all add the same ending **-ed** on it.

Examples: cook - cooked, play - played, wash - washed,

Add only **-d**.

Examples: love - loved, live - lived, close - closed, live - lived

1. Regular verbs make their Past Tense by adding -ed.
